The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 07.07.2018, registered at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib, under Sections 353, 332, 186, 506, 223, 224, 147 and 149 IPC.

As per the FIR, a police party had gone to arrest one Dilbagh Singh @ Bagga son of Amarjit Singh, when the petitioners and other persons, who were present at his house, assaulted the police party and assisted the escape of said Dilbagh Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the case is totally false and has been registered at the instance of the local MLA, who belongs to the party in power. The petitioners were not even present at spot.

The oral submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners are not sufficient to convince me that this is a false case and has been registered only on account of political rivalry. The petitioners are alleged to have prevented the police party from doing its duty and such an act cannot be taken lightly.

Thus, there is no merit in this petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.
