This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.65 dated 17.04.2015, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the allegations under the FIR are vague and no specific details have been given thereunder.

A perusal of the paper book would reflect that charges in the matter have already been framed as far back as 12.07.2016. On the asking of the court, the court is informed that the prosecution evidence has already been started and two witnesses have been examined. Under these circumstances, this court is not inclined to interfere in the matter.

At this stage, a request has been made that the matter should be referred to the Mediator for amicable settlement of disputes between the parties since, the petitioner is ready and willing to do so.

In this eventuality, this petition is being dismissed, with liberty given to the petitioner herein to move an appropriate application to the District Judge, Jalandhar for referring the matter for amicable settlement. If such an application is moved, the same be considered and an effort be made to resolve the dispute between the parties amicably.

Dismissed, with the aforesaid liberty.
