The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.62 dated 27.06.2016 registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in this case, the petitioner was earlier granted bail by the trial Court. However, he could not appear before the trial Court on the given date. Therefore, his bail bonds were cancelled and the petitioner was ultimately declared Proclaimed Offender as well on 14.05.2018. However, thereafter, the petitioner was arrested on 14.06.2018. Thereafter, the petitioner is in custody.

Counsel for the State has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner which does not dispute the factum regarding the custody of the petitioner. However, it is pointed out that two more cases are pending against the petitioner.

In response to this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already been granted bail in both the cases.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
