Though the petitioner has made multiple prayers in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC, but learned counsel for the petitioner states that except the prayer for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner, he withdraws the other prayers.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to consider the representation dated 22.06.2018 (Annexure P-1) qua the life and liberty of the petitioner only.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation on the claim so projected by the petitioner and considering the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) to the extent of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner only and to act in accordance with law.
