FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 05.09.2018 of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Manjatinder Kaur and the accused namely Hira Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise Ex.CX has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute and the offence for which the accused has been hauled up is not of heinous nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of**

Punjab and another’ 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and ‘Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another’ 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.0045 dated 21.04.2018 registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib under Section 498-A IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
