The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of complaint case No.80-2 of 2011 dated 28.05.2011 titled as "Nathu Versus Kulwant Singh and another" under Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, and Sections 323, 504, 506 IPC as well as summoning order dated 12.08.2015 (Annexures P-2 and P-3 respectively).

At this stage, Mr. Jasvir Singh Dhaliwal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed his vakalatnama, which is taken on record. He states that he has got the instructions to make a statement that his client (respondent No.2-complainant) is ready to withdraw the complaint filed by him.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition at this stage and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is made clear that in case respondent No.2-complainant fails to withdraw the complaint within one month from today, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition.
