The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 53 dated 23.05.2018, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 307, 326, 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who was allegedly armed with *Gandasa*, had caused injury on the right wrist of complainant Nachhattar Singh and on the leg of Gursewak Singh. He further contends that the injury caused on the person of Nachhattar Singh was found to be grievous in nature but he has fully recovered therefrom. The other injury caused to Gursewak Singh was simple in nature. Learned counsel contends that it was a case of cross-version, wherein two members of the petitioner party, namely, Lakhbir Singh and Hakam Singh had also received several injuries. The petitioner is in custody since 24.05.2018 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Beant Singh states that the investigation has been completed and challan has been filed before the Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the injuries alleged to have been caused by the petitioner, are on the non-vital parts of the body of the injured; he is not involved in any other case; he is in custody for almost four months; investigation has been completed and it is a case of cross-version, I deem it to be a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Sikander Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
