RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 0063 dated 13.07.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City 2 Mansa, District Mansa (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 10.08.2018 and 14.09.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Chief Judicial

Magistrate, Mansa and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 26.09.2018. Report from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mansa, vide letter No. 529 dated 27.09.2018, duly forwarded by learned District & Sessions Judge, Mansa, vide Endst. No. 5601 dated 28.09.2018, has been received. According to the report of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mansa, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 0063 dated 13.07.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City 2 Mansa, District Mansa (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
