Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for placing on record amended petition, in compliance of the order dated 10.08.2018 passed by this Court.

For the reasons stated in the application, amended petition is permitted to be taken on record and FIR No.31 dated 09.04.2018 be now read under Sections 341, 323, 353, 332, 186, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 09.04.2018 under Sections 341, 323,

District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 10.08.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohan Lal, states that no doubt the complainant has made a call to the ASI on his personal phone and thereafter, ASI has visited the scene of occurrence so as to control the situation, there he was given beating and the offence punishable under Section 323 IPC has been added along with Section 353 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the culpability as to whether the ASI got injury in the case, is yet to be established during trial and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.08.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
