Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.100 dated 12.04.2015 under Sections 420/406/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

2.) This Court vide order dated 10.08.2018 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Trial Court and join proceedings and in the event of his appearance, Trial Court was directed to release the petitioner on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its entire satisfaction.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Harjap Singh submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 10.08.2018, petitioner appeared before the Trial Court and joined the proceeding.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing

any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 10.08.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) The petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Trial Court is at liberty to initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner and his surety for violation of the bail/surety bond furnished by the petitioner.

7.) With the above observations, petition stands allowed.
