In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.149 dated 20.07.2018 registered under Section 406 IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

2. Petitioners were granted the benefit of interim bail vide order dated 10.08.2018 and directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh submitted that pursuant to the order dated 10.08.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. However, at the same time, it is submitted that if investigating officer calls the petitioner, he has to obey the order.

4. Accordingly, order dated 10.08.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
