Petitioners are present in person in the Court.

As per officer report, although respondents No. 5 and 6 have not been served but respondent No.5 is present in person in the Court and he has been identified by way of his Adhaar Card. Copy of the same is taken on record. Respondent No.5 has stated that he has no objection with the marriage of both the petitioners. He has further stated that he will not interfere in their life at all.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of. However, respondent No.2 shall continue to take care about their life and liberty of both the petitioners in accordance with law.

It is made clear that this order may not be construed as expression of an opinion on legality and validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case any criminal case is pending or lodged against petitioner No.2 this order shall not be treated as an hindrance to proceed according to law.
