This is an application filed under Order 22 Rule 3 read with Section 151 of the Civil Procedure Code for impleading the legal representative of the deceased Kailash Singh-appellant No.1. It has been submitted that Kailash Singh had expired on 29.12.2015 leaving behind his son Sukhbir Singh as his legal representative. It has also been mentioned that the appellant has not left behind any other legal heir except the applicant-Sukhbir Singh. The application is supported by affidavit of the applicant-Sukhbir Singh, son of the deceased appellant.

In view of the averments made in the application, duly supported by affidavit, the same is allowed, subject to just exceptions. Applicant-Sukhbir Singh is permitted to pursue the present litigation only. It is made clear that the present order will not be liable to be taken into consideration in any other set of proceedings. Amended memo of parties appended with the application is taken on record. Office to tag the same at relevant place of the file.
