The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.142 dated 04.03.2017, registered under Sections 307/332/353/186/429 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act and Section 5,13(2)/17 of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamverdhan Act 2015, at Police Station Model Town, Rewari.

The petitioner was arrested on 03.03.2017. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that after all the witnesses cited in the challan had been examined, an application under Section 311 of Code of Criminal Procedure was filed on behalf of prosecution for permission to examine three additional witnesses which was allowed by learned Trial Court on 21.03.2018. The matter is now stated to be fixed for examination of the additional witnesses on 10.04.2018.

In this view of the matter, this Court is not inclined to direct release of the petitioner at this stage as apparently conclusion of the trial is not likely to be taken very long time.

The matter is, therefore, disposed off with the direction to the learned Trial Court to complete the trial expeditiously as possible and preferably before the court's close for summer vacation.
