LISA GILL J. (ORAL)

This petition is for quashing of FIR No.71 dated 22.11.2015 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 19.08.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Respondent No.2 and her husband-petitioner No.1 had started residing together. However, it appears that some acrimony arose between the parties and they started living apart. In the meantime, respondent No.2 has delivered a child. It is observed by this Court on 11.05.2017 that no reasonable offer has been made by the petitioners to secure the future child. It is evident that compromise on the basis of which this petition has been filed, no longer survives.

In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
