AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a plea that he be granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that in the instant FIR, which is of January, 2014, petitioner had been appearing before the trial Court regularly, however, because of late presentation of the challan, charges were framed in the year 2017. Because of the change of the Court and there being a function in the family of the counsel, he or his counsel could not put in appearance before the trial Court on 01.11.2017, which resulted in issuance of non-bailable warrants of arrest. Counsel further contends that this was the first occasion when the petitioner had not appeared before the Court and he had been regularly appearing before the Court on all the dates, which were fixed by the trial Court. He further

contends that the petitioner has never been declared a proclaimed offender and undertakes to appear before the trial Court and submit the bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Keeping in view the statement of the counsel for the petitioner, in case the assertions of the counsel are found to be correct and the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 07.02.2018, he shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of with above observations.
