Petitioner Narsingh is in custody since the date of arrest i.e. 06.6.2018 and prays for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.623 dated 20.11.2016, under Sections 5/13(2), 17 HGS & G.S. Act, Section 25-54-59 of the Arms Act, Section 11-59-60 of the Animal Cruelty Act and Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Nuh, during pendency of the trial.

The allegations in the FIR pertain to carrying two cows and a calf in a vehicle bearing registration No.HR26S-1450 for the purpose of slaughtering. The FIR was registered on the basis of a secret information.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has argued that

the allegations regarding slaughtering are founded on presumption as the cattle recovered from the petitioner were alive. The investigation of the case is complete and challan has been filed in Court.

On the other hand learned State counsel has pointed out that the petitioner is involved in few other cases as detailed in Annexure R-1, appended with the short reply filed by way of affidavit of Sukhbir Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nuh. However, it is not disputed that in all these cases the petitioner is on bail.

Considering custody period of the petitioner, the nature of the trial, which is triable by Magistrate and is likely to consume some time, further detention of the petitioner is not justified. Therefore, without commenting anything upon merits of the case, the petitioner, namely, Narsingh is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition is allowed.
