GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.151 dated 8.4.2017 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula, District Panchkula and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 10.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula has been received to the effect that the statements of the complainant and also of the accused have been recorded as regards the factum of compromise. The complainant Deepak Malik, in his statement has stated that he has entered into a compromise with the accused and that he does not wish to proceed against the accused and has no objection in case the FIR is quashed. To the

similar effect is the joint statement of the accused. In view of the aforesaid statements, this Court is satisfied that the matter has been amicably resolved amongst the parties.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.151 dated 8.4.2017 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula, District Panchkula and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
