The petitioner is alleged to have taken loans from the private respondents, which he has allegedly re-paid alongwith interest, yet, they have not returned the documents kept with them by way of security. On the contrary, in connivance with the police, they are harassing the petitioner. Despite representation dated 19.07.2018 (Annexure P7) having been submitted, the police is refusing to take any action.

Notice of motion. Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon the private respondents, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P7) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law, if found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
