The grievance of the petitioners is that they are being harassed by the Police on account of registration of the FIR against son of petitioner No.1 and brother of petitioner No.2. His name is Jagat Ram. The said Jagat Ram has not been apprehended, as a result of which, life of the petitioners has been made miserable by the Police. A detailed representation dated 30.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted before respondent No.2 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jasdeep Singh Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5. Let six copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek written reply.

The application is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 30.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to ensure that the petitioners have not been harassed unnecessary by the Police. If it is found after enquiry that they are harassed, the needful be done within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
