JAISHREE THAKUR, J.

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 297 dated 5.12.2017 registered under Sections 342, 363, 366-A, 109, 201, 506 IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Assault Act, 2012 at Police Station Bawal, District Rewari.

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent—State submits that out of 30 witnesses 29 have been examined and the next date fixed in the trial court is 29.8.2018.

In view of the fact that the trial is likely to conclude soon, no ground is made out for grant of bail. Therefore, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to conclude the trial expeditiously.
