Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.7 dated 08.01.2014 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

The order dated 11.04.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, whereby the application filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed, does reflect that the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender on 21.10.2015.

Therefore, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner being a proclaimed offender, this Court finds that the present petition for grant of anticipatory bail is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
