1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 and further directing respondent No. 2 and 3 to decide the representation (Annexure P-6) within time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No. 2 is directed to decide representation dated 19.06.2018 (Annexure P-6), moved by the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, District SAS Nagar is directed to look into the matter and decide representations (Annexure P-3, P-4 and P-6), moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
