In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for cancellation of bail granted to the respondents No.2/Narender by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sonapat, vide order dated 20.07.2018 in case FIR No.439 dated 4.11.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307, 506, 120-B of IPC read with Section 27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonapat, District Sonapat.

2. Perusal of the order dated 20.07.2018, it is evident that Sessions Judge has apprised factual aspect to the extent of role played by the petitioner as well as accused. Para-6 of the order reads as under:

“6. Reply to the bail application filed by the State has been perused by me. The CD of CCTV footage of the house where the occurrence had taken place has been played in the Court and the same has been perused by me. It has been stated that the complainant party itself had gone to the house of the accused and started inflicting injuries to the accused persons. Co-accused Sukhvinder and Amit have already been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court. The present applicant-accused Narender is in custody since 7.6.2017 and conclusion of trial shall take considerable time. Therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, the applicant-accused Narender is admitted to bail on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties in the like amount, to the satisfaction of this Court. Papers be attached with main file.”

3. Having regard to the reasoning assigned for grant of bail, petitioner has not made out a case for cancellation of bail. Even the petitioner fails to apprise this Court whether accused violate any condition imposed by the court below.

4. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
