The grievance of the petitioner is that although his statement has been recorded by the Police, no cross FIR has been registered against respondent No.4 and his companions.

An incident of alleged assault and affray took place on 19.04.2015 resulting in registration of FIR No.44, dated 20.04.2015, registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar, under sections 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC against the petitioner and others. In respect of the same incident, the petitioner has got his statement recorded, based on which a cross-case is made out against respondent No.4 and his companions but the Police has not taken any action thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jasdeep Singh Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondent No.4

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to

objectively consider this petition as the representation and take appropriate action in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
