Heard.

It is alleged that on 30.6.2018, 7 persons one of whom was Balvir Kumar @ Monu stopped their motorcycle in front of Activa of the complainant and took away her purse containing Rs.3,000/- and some important papers. Complainant stated that he can identify the unknown persons if produced before him. Balvir Kumar was arrested. Petitioner was identified as second man on the statement of co-accused. He is absconding since the date of registration of FIR and PO proceedings are pending against him.

Considering gravity of case and the fact that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary to know about his other activities, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail.

Consequently, the present petition stands dismissed.
