The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.488, dated 27.12.2017, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Rohtak, under sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC.

The prosecution version is that one Suba sold the land of complainant to one Parvesh Devi and the petitioner impersonated Swaya Ram (erstwhile original owner of the land in dispute).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an old person and suffering from many ailments. He is only being used by the main accused and no recovery is to be effected from him. Thus anticipatory bail may be granted to him.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he impersonated the erstwhile original owner of the land in dispute and this is a serious offence and if he has played in the hands of the main accused namely Suba, he deserves to suffer the

consequences thereof. It is possible that the petitioner is member of a network involved in such activities and his custodial interrogation may lead to uncovering of illegal activities of gang dealing in preparing forged sale deeds etc.

For the aforementioned reasons, there is no merit in this petition and is accordingly dismissed.
