By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.186 dated 18.10.2015, registered under Sections 302, 307, 326, 324, 323, 148 read with Section 149 of IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.

Heard.

The learned State counsel, on instructions states that the trial is at the fag end and the case is fixed for final arguments on 27.08.2018.

Keeping in view the fact that the trial is at the fag end, therefore, this Court is not inclined to go into the merit of the case and the instant petition is dismissed.

However, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 30.03.2016, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within three months from today.
