The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.41 dated 26.06.2018, registered at Police Station Satnampura, Phagwara District Kapurthala, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only 60 tablets of Becalm 0.5 m.g. were allegedly recovered from the petitioner. However, the FSL report has not been received till date and, thus, he would be satisfied in case, the petitioner is granted interim bail till the date of receipt of the FSL report.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that the FSL report is still awaited.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court, till the date of receipt of the report of Forensic Science Laboratory. On receipt of report of the FSL, the petitioner shall surrender before the Trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned.
