The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.83 dated 21.06.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2). The same has been signed by petitioner No.1 for himself and on behalf of the petitioner Nos.2 and 3.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant submits that compromise is genuine and he accepts the same, the way its i.e. without the signatures of petitioner Nos.2 and 3.

Learned State counsel also does not dispute the execution of the compromise. He however, objects to the same on the ground that petitioner Nos.2 and 3 have not signed.

Keeping in view the fact that respondent No.2-complainant has no objection to the compromise being signed by petitioner No.1 only, the objection of the learned State counsel is liable to be rejected.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.83 dated 21.06.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala,

under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners.
