In pursuance to the order dated 15.12.2017, demand draft bearing No.711486 dated 11.09.2018 amounting to Rs.70,500/- being the cheque amount along with interest @ 9% per annum has been handed over to learned counsel for the respondent no.2 in Court. A photocopy of the same has been placed on file.

Since the entire cheque amount has been paid along with the interest, therefore, Criminal Complaint No.4583 of 2016 titled as Ashwani Kumar Kapur v. Manjir Singh pending in the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh along with consequential proceedings stand quashed.
