1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondents to nominate respondents No.6 to 8 as accused in FIR No.16, dated 13.01.2018, registered under Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana (Rural) and further to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No.4- S.H.O. Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana (Rural), is directed to decide representations dated 26.01.2018 (Annexure P-2), and dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioners.

3. In view of the above, respondent No.4- S.H.O. Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana (Rural), is directed to look into the complaint of the petitioners.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
