By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.558 dated 07.09.2015, registered under Sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B and 201 of IPC, at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner made a statement that the petitioner is ready and willing to pay a part of the amount due to him, however, she is unable to specify the amount. Today, learned counsel states that the petitioner is not ready to comply with previous order dated 05.12.2017.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer made in the present petition.

Heard.

The petitioner in connivance with other family members induced the complainant on the pretext of securing appointment of brother of the complainant and in lieu thereof, he had taken Rs.16 lakh. Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, no case for regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
