By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions for registration of FIR under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 148, 149, 34 IPC against respondents No.5 and 6 who allegedly had got the property of Ramesh Datta transferred in their name in the year 2010, on the basis of General Power of Attorney and Special Power of Attorney (Annexure P-5), although, said Ramesh Datta had already expired in the year 2008.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh (respondent No.3) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation Annexure P-1 expeditiously. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 along with Annexures P-8 to P-10 be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
