Custody certificate has been filed. Same is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.03 dated 06.01.2014, registered under Sections 307, 332, 353, 186, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.

It has been submitted that earlier the petitioner was on bail and was facing trial of the aforesaid case. However, he was found absent on 13.06.2016. Therefore, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to State. Ultimately he was declared proclaimed offender.

The petitioner is stated to have been arrested on 07.09.2016 and since then he is in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on

regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
- (d) That he will maintain peace and be of good behaviour.
