Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.56 dated 28.03.2016 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 427, 506, 452, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 29.01.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the costs of Rs.10,000/- has been deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Pal, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 are ad idem that the matter has been compromised between the parties and CRM-M-25038-2016 praying for quashing of the aforesaid FIR, on the basis of compromise, is pending for 23.07.2018.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.01.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
