The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 01.04.2017 passed in FIR No.39 dated 18.08.2016, under Sections 376-D, 312, 313, 314, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Amir Khas, District Ferozepur, vide which the petitioner has been declared as absconder of law.

By an order dated 22.09.2017, the petitioner was directed to join the trial within a period of one week and on her doing so, she was ordered to be released on interim bail by the trial court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 22.09.2017, the petitioner has joined the trial and has been released on interim bail. A certificate copy of the order dated 27.09.2017 passed by Sessions Judge, Ferozepur in this regard has been produced on

record.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions of the Investigation Officer, does not dispute this fact.

In view of the fact that pursuant to the order dated 22.09.2017 passed by this court, the petitioner has joined the trial, as such, order dated 22.09.2017 granting interim bail to the order to the petitioner is made absolute. Consequently, the impugned order dated 01.04.2017, declaring her absconder of law, is hereby set aside.

The petitioner stands disposed of accordingly.
