GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to the official respondents not to harass him in order to pressurise him to produce his son in connection with FIR No.91 dated 10.11.2008 under Sections 279 and 304-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station - Behal, Loharu, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel has submitted that one Ajay singh s/o Samunder Singh was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 15.06.2009 (Annexure P-2), whereas the petitioner has no son by the name of Ajay Singh, but he is unnecessarily being harassed by the police to produce said proclaimed offender.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-5) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

Further, in case, the petitioner is required to be associated with any inquiry or investigation or some information is to be elicited from him, then a written advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 be served upon him.

A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-5) be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
