1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made to issue appropriate directions/orders/instructions to the respondents to file the status report in FIR No. 56 dated 03.06.2018, offence under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot (Annexure P-1) to arrest the accused, who is roaming free and threatening and pressurizing the petitioner and his family to withdraw from the prosecution and to bring home the guilt.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No. 2 is directed to decide representation dated 06.07.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner.
3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Punjab Police, Faridkot, Punjab is directed to look into the matter and decide representation (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
