Petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking concession of anticipatory bail in a complaint case bearing No.98-I, dated 24.08.2015, under Sections 420/120-B IPC pending in the Court of learned JMIC, Hisar.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 13.09.2017:

“It is inter-alia contended that the petitioner has been summoned in a criminal complaint and that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Notice of motion for 19.01.2018.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall put in appearance before the trial Court within seven days from today and on his doing so he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned counsel representing the petitioner has furnished in Court today a copy of order dated 18.09.2017 passed by JMIC, Hisar and which would reflect that the petitioner/accused, Rajinder Kumar has

surrendered before the Court and was admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and with one surety in the like amount.

The petitioner having joined trial proceedings upon having been summoned in a criminal complaint, the prayer made in the petition is accepted. Order dated 13.09.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute.
