The petitioners are allegedly in live-in-relationship. They fear for their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 7 to 13. Despite representation dated 06.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) having been submitted the police is not taking care of the interest of the petitioners.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 6 only.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 6. Let seven copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 06.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Meanwhile, it shall be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners.
