Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case arising from FIR No.170 dated 19.06.2018 under Sections 392/342/506/120-B IPC and later on added Section 347 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran.

According to the prosecution, petitioner No.1, with the aid of his wife Veera Sharma @ Veeran Sharma, who is mother of petitioners No.2 and 3, have formed a gang and are robbing the innocent person on the false pretext by Veeran Sharma asking them to give lift to her on their vehicles, taking them to their house and then, snatching away their valuables on the pretext of implicating them falsely in some criminal case of outraging her modesty. Not only that, they also give beatings to them.

Perusal of impugned order dated 25.07.2018 of the learned Additional Sessions Judge Tarn Taran rejecting the prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail to them, shows that the petitioners are also involved in 7 more criminal cases detailed therein for committing heinous

crimes like cheating, fraud, snatching, attempt to murder, outraging the

modesty and breach of trust etc.

Considering the above facts and overall circumstances of the case,
the petitioners do not deserve any concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
