This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 03.06.2017 in case FIR No.100 dated 02.06.2017, under Section 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

[2]. From the available material, it transpires that the petitioner's name was reviewed in the suicide note of the deceased victim. The allegations made out in the suicide note against the petitioner do not at all tally with the alleged false FIR lodged against the deceased on 01.06.2017.

[3]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, in the circumstances, he may at the stage be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
