This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 436, 427, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of Explosive Substance Act, 1908 later on added by the police, at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda, vide FIR No.198 dated 25.08.2017.

Petitioner is are stated to be in custody for more than five months. Allegations are that he instigated co-accused to commit crime. Investigation has been completed and challan has been presented before the trial court. So, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.
