In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in case/FIR No.267 dated 15.07.2018 under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurugram.

Having regard to the seriousness of the allegations against the petitioners that they have threatened the deceased on the previous day of deceased death to the extent that they would kill him. Such a threat was made before the complainant at complainant's house and to the deceased from mobile number 8503075656. Both the petitioners visited deceased's residence on the previous date of the deceased's death. Petitioners have not made out a case so as to seek anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
