The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5 as respondent No.5 is threatening the petitioner and his family members that either to give him money or be ready to face dire consequences.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Punjab to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. He/she is further directed to submit status report before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.**
