REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

Pawan Kumar, the injured victim is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injuries sustained by him in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 24.04.2002.

The Tribunal has awarded compensation of Rs.25,000/-.

Counsel for the parties have arrived at a consensus that compensation allowed in favour of Pawan Kumar may be enhanced and the injured is allowed a sum of Rs.40,000/- over and above compensation allowed by the Tribunal and no interest shall be payable on additional amount of Rs.40,000/- in case the insurance company deposits the additional amount with the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Sangrur within a period of two months.

In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of. However, in case the insurance company fails to deposit the additional amount within the stipulated period, claimant shall be entitle to interest on the additional amount @ 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till realization.
