Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.77 dated 11.03.2016 for the offences punishable under Sections 420,467,468,471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is regarding, allegedly, fabricating the certificate of having passed the 8th class. It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that for some reason, the Election of the petitioner as Sarpanch was challenged in an Election Petition. Although that Election Petition was allowed by the Trial Court, however, the matter is pending before the Division Bench of this Court in which 'notice of motion' has been issued. It is still further contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that although the certificate of the petitioner is genuine, however, in any case; all the documents are already with the Police. The petitioner's custody is no more

required for any recovery purpose. Therefore, no purpose would be served by keeping him in custody.

On the other hand learned State counsel, being instructed by ASI, Parminder has not disputed the fact given by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
