GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Petitioners – Manwinder Kaur and Rupinder Singh and have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 to 6, who are parents and brother of petitioner No.1. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of her Aadhar Card to the effect that she is aged 25 years and petitioner No.2 has annexed copy of his driving licence indicating his age as 26 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

Atinderpal Singh-respondent No.6, who is brother of petitioner No.1 is present in person, who desired to speak his sister i.e. petitioner No.1 and was permitted to do so for about 5 minutes outside the Court room. After having spoken to his sister, respondent No.6-Atinderpal Singh appeared again in the Court and stated that he does not have any objection to marriage and that he would not take law in his hands.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, the aforesaid order shall not be taken to be any expression regarding validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
