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**MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (ORAL)**

Present petition is filed praying for quashing FIR No.228 dated 25.8.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sahlawas, District Jhajjar on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties.

Mr. Abhimanyu Singh, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 by filing power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Heard.

Both the parties were directed by this Court vide order dated

13.9.2017 to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court and get their statements recorded and in pursuance thereof, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jhajjar, recorded the statements of both the parties and submitted a report dated 1.11.2017. A perusal of the report reveals that the compromise entered into between the parties is voluntary and without any fear, coercion, inducement or threat. Even as on today the parties are not disputing the factum of compromise arrived at between them.

Even the learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jagbir submitted that cancellation report has been prepared in this case.

No objection has also been raised by the learned State counsel on a specific query put to him by the Court with regard to quashing of the FIR as well as all other consequential proceedings on the basis of the compromise effected between the parties in this case.

Inasmuch as the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and they have already entered into compromise, and the fact that no objection has been raised by the State, continuance of the prosecution would be an exercise in futility. Therefore, the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings resulting therefore are quashed.

Petition is allowed.
